The estate was given by the Duke of Alba to his wife in celebration of winning one of his battles against the Moors. More recently it was used for many years as a farm school for children from the Malaga area. Now it makes a truly unique and special home. If you are looking for a rural property full of charm and character, then this could be your dream home The property comprises 4 Double Bedrooms with built in wardrobes. 2 en-suite and one with a vanity unit. One bedroom is currently used as an office. 3 full Bathrooms and 1 separate w.c. Large Andalucian style Kitchen Large Living room with a log burner and stunning rock feature wall Good size dining room with access to the old mill Huge family 4 piece bathroom Office Attached to the house at the rear there is an annexe that is currently being used to teach Yoga and has enough room to install an open plan kitchen, lounge, diner and full bathroom, plus 2 additional rooms that could be bedrooms. The whole house is full of charming touches, but the mill rooms are fascinating with the ancient workings still in place. There is 17500 m2 land, stable block with two stalls, a tack room and fenced paddock, the property is ideal for keeping animals. The land is mainly level and irrigated, with more than 50 fruiting trees, garden patio areas and a small plantation of poplar trees. One section of land is on the side of the hill with an unreformed cave that's being used to store hay. The property is sold partly furnished. Large section of the gardens are gated and fenced, excellent for pets. The area abounds with wildlife and there is fantastic riding country with tracks on your doorstep.
