The estate was given by the Duke of Alba to his wife in celebration of winning one of his battles against the Moors. More recently it was used for many years as a farm school for children from the Malaga area. Now it makes a truly unique and special home. If you are looking for a rural property full of charm and character, then this could be your dream homeThe property comprises4 Double Bedrooms with built in wardrobes. 2 en-suite and one with a vanity unit. The whole house is full of charming touches, but the mill rooms are fascinating with the ancient workings still in place. There is 17500 m2 land, stable block with two stalls, a tack room and fenced paddock, the property is ideal for keeping animals. The land is mainly level and irrigated, with more than 50 fruiting trees, garden patio areas and a small plantation of poplar trees. One section of land is on the side of the hill with an unreformed cave thats being used to store hay. The property is sold partly furnished.
