Lovingly cared for and maintained, it presents an exceptional opportunity in one of Granada's most picturesque rural locations.

Exceptional Outdoor Space ■Outside, a generous tiled terrace provides both sun-drenched and shaded seating areas — ideal for quiet mornings, long lunches, or unforgettable sunset dining. A large gravelled area extends the outdoor living options and includes a garage and wood shed, along with ample space for gardening, extra seating, or leisure activities.

■Unusually for a cave house, the property also boasts its own garden, large enough to accommodate an above-ground swimming pool.

Light-Filled, Welcoming Interiors ■Designed around a central light tower, the interior enjoys abundant natural brightness — a rare advantage for a cave property. The living room and kitchen form a warm and inviting heart of the home. The main bedroom benefits from dual-aspect windows for enhanced light and comfort, while the spacious second bedroom offers a peaceful retreat for family or guests.

■Attached to one of the double bedrooms is a small undeveloped cave, which, once converted, would make a fabulous en-suite.

Flexible Layout ■The current dining room could be converted into a third bedroom if desired, and the separate office next to the living area offers excellent versatility. It would make an ideal nursery, creative workspace, or cosy reading room.

Traditional Style with Modern Comfort ■The kitchen features charming Andalusian tiles, lattice-fronted cabinetry, and granite worktops, combining rustic appeal with practical modernity. The bathroom includes a stylish walk-in shower framed by glass blocks to maximise natural light.

■A log-burning stove set within a stone-clad chimney brings warmth and character on cooler days, while a solar-powered hot water boiler ensures efficient everyday living.

Modern Utilities – A Rare Advantage ■Unlike many cave homes, this property is fully connected to mains electricity, mains water, and mains sewage, delivering convenience and reliability from day one.

Peaceful Rural Setting with Great Connections ■Cortijo Del Cura is surrounded by dramatic landscapes typical of northern Granada. The village sits approximately 5 km from Castelléjar, and around 15 km from Huéscar, a larger town offering shops, restaurants, supermarkets, weekly market, and essential services. The wider area is known for its natural beauty, traditional cave dwellings, and peaceful rural lifestyle.

■For accessibility: the nearest main airports are Granada-Jaén Airport, about 90 km away, and Almería Airport, approximately 130 km — making the property reachable in roughly 1–1.5 hours by car. For additional amenities and variety: the historic town of Baza is around 45 km from the property — perfect for a day out exploring local culture and services. For beach and coastal leisure, the attractive seaside resort of Mojácar lies about 110 km away, offering Mediterranean beaches and coastal lifestyle within reasonable driving distance.
