The property offers full climate control and combines Scandinavian oak flooring with porcelain surfaces of the highest quality throughout. This Villa boasts two impressive entrance gateways that lead to an internal parking area capable of accommodating multiple cars. A landscaped courtyard with a beautiful fountain feature enhances the surroundings, while a large underground garage and storage area provide ample space for storage needs.
